### Meeting Minutes submitted by Jo Carol Carter

- The Feb 20, 2014, meeting of the Bluegrass Tolers was held at the Extension Building in Versailles, KY. The lesson was presented by Sowmya Viji. The project was an acrylic Barnyard Tulip design by Judy Ribitch.
- Marsha Clark presided at the meeting an agenda is attached. The September 19, 2013, minutes were read and approved.
- Attending 12 members were: Marsha Clark, Connie Bolin, Mina McLean, Debbie McQueary, Jo Carol Carter, Cathy Hall, Carolyn Leet, Mary Lou Payton, Barbara Ryan, Byrle Thomas, Sowmya Viji and Nina Parker.
- The luncheon was pizza. Debbie McQueary was given information collected on having lunches catered. She will review the information and give her recommendations at next meeting.
- The financial report was submitted by Byrle Thomas. The 12/31/13 balance is \$4487.77. The report is attached. A motion was made by Jo Carol Carter seconded by Connie Bolin to accept the report. The motion was approved.
- 2014 Projects were discussed. Mina will finalize the projects, including the possibility of a
  May session with a national teacher, for the club to review. A motion was made by Jo Carol
  Carter and seconded by Mary Lou Payton, rather than discussing possibilities without details
  have Mina bring a list of projects for 2014. We know Mina has the expertise to make good
  choices for the club's approval. The motion was approved.
- 2013 Conference items: Mary Lou Payton was pleased with the conference boutique. She
  may not be available to work the Boutique in 2014. She is updating the 2013 form with
  information learned from her work at the club's first boutique. A motion was made by Byrle
  Thomas seconded by Nina Parker to increase the club Boutique's profit from 10% to 20% in
  2014. The motion was approved.
- Marsha Clark outlined details for a "Social Painting with Friends." Marsha showed examples of projects suitable for a social. The club would sponsor the event and it may be held at Marsha and Connie's church donating a portion of the proceeds to the churches mission work. Deco Art has an Art Kit for sale that Mina McLean thinks would be perfect for the event. Byrle Thomas and others have worked this type of event in the past and think it is a very workable fund event for the club. A motion was made by Byrle Thomas seconded by Connie Bolin for Marsha Clark to research dates and other particulars involved with the social and Mina McLean will check with Deco Art about the availability of the Art Kits. The group targeted will be 14 years and up. The motion was approved.
- Sowmya Viji shared a fact sheet about the international 'We Serve' Foundation. The
  foundation accepts used and new books to benefit poor students. The goal is 120,000 free
  public libraries. Sowmya asked club member to get involved and donate any books they
