



Biographies of Our Retreat Instructors

Jude Creager

Judith Creager began drawing and painting at an early age. Her mother sent her to the Art Academy at the age of eight. She majored in art in high school; then, life, husband, children slowed her down. She did not draw or paint until sometime in the mid-seventies when she conducted an off-site art program in her home for eighth graders from a local school. This not-for-pay job was a great experience for both Jude and the kids. In fact, two of the students became relatives, one a step- daughter and one a daughter-in-law. In 1977, Jude then began taking oil classes from a local artist who conducted classes in her home. She now has her own art shop and teaches each week on Tuesday.

Arthur Evans

Arthur Evans is a native of West Virginia; he lived in California for 27 years where he taught German at the Defense Language Institute. By 1989 he began his career as a self-employed artist. Although primarily self-taught, he received instruction from several professional artists. The quality of his work is outstanding and shows his inherited talent and knowledge of painting. His works can be found in private collections throughout the United States.

In 2003, Arthur returned to the Charleston area of West Virginia, where he continues his artistic endeavors. Recently, Arthur was commissioned to paint a total of 20 portraits of all past and present Court Judges of Kanawha County.

Arthur is a patient and articulate instructor. He gives each student individual personal attention, answering questions, offering constructive criticism and demonstrating solutions to problems. If a student comes to his class willing to learn, he/she will be greatly rewarded for his/her effort.
